Community Asset transfers from Waverley Borough Council
Update to Full Council November 2026

Progress with the applications for community asset transfer is summarised in the table below. Of note:

Beacon Hill Recreation ground is not owned by WBC, they are trustees of the Charity which own the freehold. The Clerk has asked that the trusteeship of the land be transferred to HTC. Awaiting outcome.

The application to take over Lion Green Locality office has been withdrawn as HTC would not be able to use the building due to long leases in the process of being renewed.

The application to take Beacon Hill car park has been withdrawn as WBC now have plan to introduce parking restrictions at the site and are better placed to conduct enforcement if these are not adhered to.

High Street public toilets	Essential asset for the town, however, form part of a larger freehold which covers the key site.
