24/26 LGR LAND TRANSFERS – NEXT STEPS

The Clerk had provided a written update for councillors with the agenda. Councillors discussed the level of delegation that the Clerk should be given in respect of progressing the CAT transfers.

RESOLVED

- I. That the Town Clerk is given full delegation to act on behalf of the council in progressing the transfer of the parcels of land that HTC has applied for under the CAT process. To include but not limited to:
 - a. Agreeing Heads of Terms and instructing the council’s solicitors to take the transfers forward.
 - b. Agreeing changes to the CAT application that would resolve any outstanding issues preventing the transfers, including removing the cottage and yard at Woolmer Hill.
 - c. Instructing the council’s grounds care contractor to being maintenance of the transferred sites.
- II. That the Clerk is authorised to Instruct the council’s website management to make changes to the online booking at a cost of £1020 +VAT. To be paid for from underspend in the small grants / green grants budget, but to be shown against a relevant LGR cost code.

25/26 TOWN MEADOW PLAYGROUND DESIGN & FENCING

The council had previously been provided with a report from the Deputy Town Clerk.

RESOLVED: That the previously agreed playground specification is amended to include new 1m Playspec fencing, galvanised, at an additional cost of £7,084.
