




# HASLEMERE TOWN COUNCIL



**Proposal to add a couple of street lamps on the footpath between the Sturt Farm development and Hedgehog Lane**

**Sturt Farm Development**





**What?**  
A couple of streetlamps on footpath 35 in the location highlighted. Wildlife and dark skies compliant.

**Why?**  
Security and safety. It's really dark here and lots of people walk the route. Residents have asked for this.

**How?**  
Neither the Housing Association nor Surrey PROW are required to do this, but we must work with them to achieve it.

Bid to neighbourhood CIL for capital costs. Energy use and maintenance tbc. The simplest option would be adoption by Highways.

Wildlife and dark skies compliant lights are only marginally more expensive and because much of the expense will be connection and labour the difference is negligible.
